Dear Parents and Carers,

As mentioned in the newsletter, Sports Day 2024 will be taking place on **Wednesday 19th June 2024**. We are pleased to inform you that parents will be very welcome to attend the event to watch their children. There will be designated areas on the school site for parents to stand to watch or follow their children around the events. However, please be aware of other events going on and be prepared to move slightly if a member of staff asks you to.

- **Reception** children's events will take place between (approximately): 9:00am – 10:00 am.
- **Years 1, 2 and 3** children's events will take place between (approximately): 10:15 – 11:45 am.
- **Years 4, 5 and 6** children's events will take place between (approximately): 1:30 – 3:00 pm.

All sessions for children in Year 1 and above will take place on the large playground and grass area. Reception children will be taking part in their events together on the main grass area.

All children will take part in a variety of different events in a carousel, with each child completing every event for their age group. The children will compete with other children in their houses, and everyone will score points for their teams. This is a great way for the children to showcase their amazing teamwork, honesty and resilience skills that they have been working on all year.

All children should come to school wearing a t-shirt that is the same colour as their house team. The house colours are **Farah (Red)**; **Ennis-Hill (Yellow)**; **Thompson (Green)** and **Daley (Blue)**.

If your child does not have a t-shirt of their house colour, a plain white t-shirt (or their usual red PE top) will be fine, and the children will be given a sticker to show which house they are in.

Please send the children into school with the following: a jumper; a hat; a water bottle and wearing their kit as there will not be time for them to change in school time. In case it is sunny, please ensure that you put suncream on your child before they come to school.
