### Maths

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100 up to 1000.
- Estimating and rounding numbers to the find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones).
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas.

### English

- Consistently use capital letters and full stops correctly.
- Understand statements, commands, questions and exclamations.
- Use prepositions such as under, around and next.
- Use expanded noun phrases to describe.
- Spell some words correctly from the Year 3 list.
- Begin to use fronted adverbials in their writing.
- Use coordination such as and, or, but.
- Produce legible joined handwriting.

### Reading

It is really important that the children are reading at home every day. We aim for at least 15 minutes every day. Children can read their assigned Accelerated Reader books and those that they enjoy too. Please try to read with your child regularly to help their progress. Remember that reading with and to your child will help them with their writing too!

### Homework

Homework is online. There will be Mathletics and Spelling Shed homework set that can all be accessed weekly. We will ensure that the children's logins are sent home when they are ready. If we feel necessary, additional paper-based homework may be sent home. Throughout the year, please support your child to complete activities towards their SAGE award. Occasionally, we may send out ideas about tasks that pupils can do to work towards their SAGE award. Please ask if you have any questions regarding this.
